




Software cannot just be ENGINEERED! It's a craft.

 - Increase maintainability



Working software **OVER** comprehensive documentation


Customer collaboration OVER contract negotiation

Responding to change **OVER** following a plan



Eliminate Waste!

- Waste: Anything that does not create value for the customer
 - A part sitting around waiting to be used
 - Making something that's not immediately needed
 - Motion / hand-off / transfer of work
 - Waiting
 - Defects
- In software anything besides analysis and coding is waste!
- Optimize
- Constant communication
- Rapid Feedback
 - Deliver rapidly... long development cycles are waste!
